It is the only national cemetery containing both World War I and World War II ePOW interments: Ninety-two (92) World War I German ePOWs and One-hundred-eight (108) World War II ePOWs including: One-hundred-and-five (105) Germans, one (1) Italian, one (1) Frenchman, and one (1) Polish from World War II. Twelve (12) of the World War II ePOWs were originally interred at Camp Butner, NC
